Will those at the Pinnacle of the Three Branches of Government survive the assaults of Progress better than the charwomen, coachmen, seamsters and other teamsters of lore?

PREMISE

With regard to the Legislative Branch of Government, in the current 117th Congress 32.7% of Representatives and 50% of Senators hold law degrees;

Now, will the powerful agents of the Three Branches of Government be more successful in defending their own turf? One could bet that they will fight tooth and nail to conserve their power and prerogatives and, being at the right end of the levers of power, chances are they will succeed, at least for a while.

The augury they seem to dread so much is hereby called **B.A.D.A.S.S.**³.

Much has been said about the novelty, but to allay one's possible doubts about its benefits and the shortcomings of Natural Intelligence, suffice it to read the abundance of naturally unintelligent and panic-ridden comments about so-called Artificial Intelligence.

More to the point, it has been verified upon testing the latest iteration of the new technology that it exceeded the performance of **90 percent** of human test takers on the Uniform Bar Examination, a standardized test used to certify lawyers for practice in many states. Similar improvements were found in dozens of other standardized tests.

By extension, could it be inferred that the novelty will replace altogether and with great advantage to the public the laureates of the Bar Examination? Let's examine the proposition more closely.

For one thing, while the Fellows of the Brotherhood of the Practitioners of the Law bill their patrons in increments of one tenth of an hour, irrespective of any obligation of result, much like the Fillies of the Sisterhood of the Servants of Aphrodite, the Artificially Intelligent novelty is and probably will remain free of charge, thus sparing the client from being charged for one hour sometimes as much as he earns in a fortnight.

Then, unlike some in the Brotherhood personally known to the author of these lines, the novelty is certain to be neither lazy, indolent, greedy, unprincipled, prejudiced, insensitive, arrogant, unethical, untrustworthy, deceitful, unscrupulous, duplicitous, predatory, cunning, underhanded, grandstanding nor altogether dishonorable.

The novelty will expeditiously analyze litigation premises and thoroughly check evidence in a purely factual and logical fashion. It will instantly parse through jurisprudence and denounce bad law.
